



## St Rita's College 2022 Netball Season Information Pack

St Rita's is in the process of establishing **St Rita's College (SRC) Club Netball** within the Downey Park Netball Association (DPNA) for 2022. As a new program for the College, this is a very exciting time for St Rita's Netball and for everyone involved.

### Club Netball

SRC Club Netball will be the main focus of the Netball Program pathway at St Rita's College.

Netballers playing for SRC Club will be provided with highly experienced and skilled netball coaches that will help take their game to the next level, on and off the court.

Trainings will take place one afternoon a week starting from Week 2 of Term 1 2022. Exact training times and locations will be finalised upon final selections of teams.

SRC Club Netball will be played every Saturday morning from 23 April – 13 August 2022 with finals up to 3 September 2022 at Downey Park Netball Association.

### Coaching

We understand the importance of having coaches who help grow and develop you/your daughter's netball game on and off the court, and we will ensure that your daughter will be in good hands.

Once we have filled the coaching positions, parents and team members will be notified. The coaches will then be in contact with each team member.

### Trials

- The **first Trial** for SRC Netball will be held on Tuesday 9 November from 3:30pm -5:30pm at the St Rita's College outdoor courts.
- The **second Trial** will be held on Thursday 11 November from 3:30pm-5:30pm at the St Rita's College outdoor courts.

Students must attend both trials.

*It is essential that the **Nomination form for Trials** be submitted by 4 November. Please refer to the specific Nomination form information at the close of this communication.*

The Trials selection panel will include the College Heads of Netball, Miss Lara Dunkley and Mrs Gretel Bueta, assisted by a third-party selector from the Queensland Firebirds.

Girls of all skill levels are welcome to trial. Parents/Carers and their daughters are also asked to look carefully at all their commitments before indicating their wish to trial.

Teams are formed on the basis of student interest balanced against available quality coaching and training venues. Students must attend trials to be considered for selection. Whilst the College is committed wherever possible to giving all triallists a position in a team, unfortunately, at times, this is not always possible.

### **Fees**

Fees for SRC Club Netball are \$420 for the season. This includes Netball Queensland and DPNA membership/playing fees, coaching, club shirt, court hire and all other team costs.

The fee will be added to your School Fees account at the commencement of Term 1 2022. Families of incoming enrolled students who don't yet hold a College fee account will be invoiced directly.

SRC Netball operates on a No-Pay, No-Play philosophy. All registrations and fees must be paid prior to the first game in April.

If you have any issues with fees, please contact us, as we are happy to assist in answering any questions.

### **Uniforms**

There will be a requirement to play in an SRC Netball dress uniform, that will be available for purchase at the Boutique. Further information regarding uniforms and the process for ordering will be released once teams are selected.

### **Managers**

Once teams are finalised, expressions of interest will be sought for Team Managers.

### **Submission of Nomination Form – required by Thursday 4 November.**

If your daughter wishes to trial for SRC Club Netball parental submission of the Nomination form is required. Please ensure you read the Terms and Conditions, which include training and match dates, and complete and submit the Nomination form by **Thursday 4 November 2021**.

The Nomination form may only be submitted by parents/carers. By submitting the Nomination form, parents/carers and their daughter are committing to the Terms and Conditions of playing sport for the College should selection for a team be successful.

## St Rita's College 2022 Netball Season Terms and Conditions

### SELECTION

- Selection Trials for Netball will be held and are compulsory. Selections will be based on previous season commitment levels to team training; matches and; ability level
- Girls of all abilities are welcome to trial.
- Parents/Carers and their daughters are advised to look carefully at all their commitments before indicating their willingness to compete.
- If your daughter is not able to fulfil all commitments for the entire season, she should not nominate her interest.
- The online nomination form must be submitted by the due date to be considered for selection.
- Submission of the online nomination form confirms your daughter's commitment and your support of that commitment to any team for which she may be selected in.
- If a student is away from trials due to illness or personal reasons, it is the parent's responsibility to inform the Director of Sport and/or a relevant member of the Sports Department in writing notifying of your daughter's absence.
- The number of teams to be entered is unknown until after nominations have closed and coach availability has been confirmed. Students who have completed their nomination on time will be given the opportunity to join a team or withdraw if oversubscribed.

### COMMITMENT

- Required commitment of team members is 100% attendance at training and matches.
- If for any reason a selected team member is unavailable for training due to illness/injury, then the team member, if able to do so, should email Director of Sport and team coach explaining of their absence from i.e. training or match.
- If for any reason a selected team member is unavailable due to illness/injury for a match, then the parents are to notify the Director of Sport and team coach via email as early as possible prior to the match. All coach email addresses are available on MySRC.
- Complete withdrawal from a team will only be granted on medical grounds and upon receipt of a medical professional's certificate outlining reasoning – this is to be presented and discussed with the Director of Sport and/or member of the Sports Department.

### WITHDRAWAL AFTER SELECTION

Withdrawal from a team after selection will only be granted for special circumstances e.g. medical etc., and upon receipt of a medical professional's certificate/letter specifying the reasons. The request is to be presented and discussed with the Director of Sport and/or relevant member of the Sports Department. If necessary, the request may be referred to the Principal. If injured or too ill to participant physically, it is preferable for students to be encouraged to remain with their team and act as an official and/or supporter of the team.

### SELECTION AND TRIALS

Attendance at Trials is compulsory to be selected in a St Rita's Netball Team. All trials will be held at the Netball Courts on the College grounds. Parents must have submitted their daughter's nomination form to be eligible to trial. Students are to attend both trials.

**Trial #1** Tuesday 9 November 2021: 3:30pm – 5:30pm at St Rita's College

**Trial #2** Thursday 11 November 2021: 3:30pm – 5:30pm at St Rita's College

### TRAINING

If selected, training commences for all teams on their set training day of the week.

Students will need to be available for one training session per week. Training sessions for specific teams will be confirmed after trials.

### 2022 MATCH DETAILS

Matches are played on Saturday mornings

**Dates:** 23 April – 13 August with finals up to 3 September.

Please note that these dates are a guide only. Draws will not be released until closer to the season.

**Venue:** Downey Park Netball Association.



## FEES

- Fees for the St Rita's College 2022 Club Netball Season are \$420
- Fees are payable prior to the commencement of the playing season
- Once the student's acceptance into a team has been confirmed to parents/carers by email, fees will be charged as per below. Payment of the full season's fee is the only way to secure a place.
- Any students who have not made payment will forfeit their place in the team.
- Payment for team members who are current St Rita's College students will be made via School Fee accounts.
- Payment for non-St Rita's College Students must be made via BPOINT using the link to be provided in the confirmation email.
- Team players will be required to pay additional fees to participant in competitions such as State and National Titles. Fees will be determined for each competition and will be payable prior to participation in the competition.
- Netball fees are not transferable or refundable
- New enrolments throughout the Term will pay upfront on a pro-rata basis.
- There are no refunds or credits for any missed training sessions, including for reasons of illness, injury, holidays and cancelled sessions for bad weather

## TRANSPORT

All transport to and from training and matches is the responsibility of parents/carers. Students wishing to walk home or catch alternative transport (e.g. with other students' parents) from a venue must present a parental note to their Coach or the Head Coach Netball for permission to be granted. One note is sufficient if the arrangement is for the entire season. Students who choose to drive to and from trainings and matches do not have permission to take other students in their vehicle unless this is requested in writing by all families involved.

## OPEROO (Medical records/instructions)

Parents of current students are to ensure their daughter's Operoo profile is always up to date as team coaches require this information in case of any incident. Parents of incoming St Rita's students will be requested to provide a medical profile prior to commencement of the season.
